SWIM NOVA SCOTIA MEET SANCTION FORM

PART I – REQUIREMENTS FOR SANCTION

1. All competitive Swimming Meets, Time Trials and Competitions, other than water polo, synchronized swimming competition and diving meets conducted in Nova Scotia should be sanctioned by a delegated member of the Board of Directors of Swim Nova Scotia. Aquatic Display meets, etc., which include speed swimming events should also be sanctioned. Records apparently set in unsanctioned competitions will not be recognized by Swimming Canada.
2. To receive sanction, the following stipulations must be met:
 - a) The sponsoring of club or organization must be affiliated with Swim Nova Scotia
 - b) All Canadian competitors must be registered with Swim Nova Scotia; competitors from other countries must be registered with an organization recognized by F.I.N.A.
 - c) All rules and laws of Swim Nova Scotia and F.I.N.A. must be adhered to.
 - i) The proposed entry forms including program of events, and qualifying times (if any), meet rules, showing date, time and location of the competitions must be mailed to Swim Nova Scotia.
3. Swim Nova Scotia, by granting sanction may be able to render assistance in the following areas:
 - a) Swim Nova Scotia can provide assistance and guidance in organizing and conducting the competition.
 - b) Necessary equipment, such as stopwatches, starting system (\$25 rental), time cards, etc. may be provided.
 - c) Officials to work at the meet, such as referee, judges, timers, marshalls, recorders and announcers may be provided.
 - d) Confirmation that all competitors have an amateur status (i.e. are registered with Swim Nova Scotia).
 - e) Recognition and publication of all National and Provincial records set at the meet.
 - f) Assuring that there are no conflicting competitions sanctioned for the date of your competition within the Nova Scotia area.
 - g) Assistance in publicizing your meet.
